- All Classes £20 each. First Aid per Rider £5
- Team entry is free but all riders must be entered online before the closing date. Teams to be emailed by DC or team manager to kjwakelin@icloud.com by Wednesday 11th March

Rules

- 1. The competition will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping 2020 Rule Book and the Winter Series 2019/2020 Rule Book. Entry is taken as acceptance of these rules.
- 2. Any combination of rider and horse who qualify for both the Winter League and the Open Grand Prix Championships in the same year must nominate which class they wish to compete in on the day they qualify so that the other qualification can be passed down the line.
- 3. Combination of rider and horse can qualify for both the Debut Championship and Winter League Championship in the same year but cannot qualify for the Open Grand Prix Final.
- 4. Riders may not compete in both Debut and Open classes.
- 5. The decision of the judge is final. Objections must be made to the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the incident.
- 6. All hats must comply to current Pony Club rules and be tagged before competing. Hats should be tagged by the member's own branch before the event. Please bring any untagged hats to the secretary's office when collecting numbers.
- 7. Legal Liability: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 8. Health and Safety: Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
