The deadline for entries is Tuesday 29th October 2019. Get your entries in early, as classes will close when full. On the day entries will be accepted if the classes are not full and will attract a £5 surcharge. **CASH ONLY ON THE DAY.**

ROSETTES & PRIZES

We will be awarding rosettes to 8th place in each class. Clear round rosettes will be awarded to all those who jump clear but are not placed in Class 1.

A horsemanship prize will be awarded in each class, judged by Posy Knapp BHSI Equestrian Coaching and sponsored by The Scott Family

Conditions of Entry

1. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
2. The completion is being run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2019.
3. The decision of the judges and stewards in all cases is final.
4. Any objections must be made in writing and handed in to the show secretary within 15 minutes of the incident happening with a deposit of £10.00. In the event that the objection is sustained the deposit will be refunded.
5. Excessive use of the whip, including repeated slapping down the shoulder, is prohibited. The whip may be used a **maximum of three times** during any round. Use of the whip will be monitored and excessive use may result in elimination.
6. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
7. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
8. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Woodland Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.
9. Horses and ponies must be four years or older on the day of the show.
10. All competitors must be suitably dressed in correct riding attire. Hats must be approved PAS015, EN1384 or BS EN1384 with BSI Kitemark and chin straps must be correctly fastened at all times when mounted.
11. All entries must be accompanied by the correct fee; each rider will be charged £5 extra towards the cost of Paramedic Cover.
12. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
13. The Organisers reserve the right to alter the programme of events at their discretion and should the event be cancelled for any reason the Organisers reserve the right to retain a proportion of entry fees to cover their expenses.
14. Combinations competing in Class 1 are not permitted to compete in Classes 3 and above.
15. Classes 4 and 5 will run under Pony Club Show Jumping 2019 Rule Book and the Winter Series 2019/20 Rule Book. Copies can be obtained from Pony Club HQ or viewed on the Pony Club website, www.pcuk.org
16. Substitution of entries. A rider may request to substitute a horse/pony for a class that he/she has entered, if the secretary is so advised before the start of the class. **Horse and rider may not** be substituted —this is in effect a completely different entry!
17. In the interests of safety and the smooth running of the event, all competitors, their family and friends must follow the instructions of show officials, and this includes directions as to the parking of vehicles.
18. Horses/ ponies tied to the outside of trailers/lorries **must not** be left unattended.
19. **Please ensure that the area around your horse box/trailer is left clean and tidy and any droppings are removed! Tying of haynets on the outside of trailers/lorries is not permitted.**
20. There will be no refund of entry fees without production of a Doctor's certificate or Veterinary certificate within 7 days of the competition and any refunds made will be subject to an administration fee.
21. **Entry to events at Berkshire College does not entitle riders or visitors to use other equestrian facilities, including the grass rides and the cross country areas. Riders or visitors are not entitled to be anywhere on the estate other than the specific facilities hired for the Show. Anyone found on the estate will be banned from ALL future equestrian events at this venue.**

Class 5 (Classes 5a and 5b will run concurrently) 5a - Winter League Preliminary Qualifier Only Pony Club members can compete in Class 5a 5b - Winter Challenge (open to all)	90cm	£15
Class 6 – Open Jumping Kindly sponsored by Karn Herbert Farriers	1m approx	£14
A compulsory £5 paramedic cover will be applied to every competitor.

All classes will run as a single-phase competition.

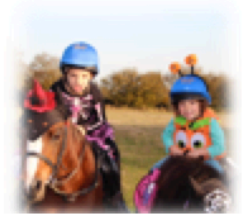
Please note combinations competing in Class 1 may not compete in Classes 3 and above.

PRELIM ROUNDS DEBUT & WINTER LEAGUE

Held throughout the country from: **1st October 2019 – 28th February 2020.**

Area Qualifier dates can be found on the Pony Club website.
Members and non Members may compete at Prelim Rounds in any Area.

Qualifiers must have jumped a clear round in the first round or first phase if run under single or two phase.

All Prelim Qualifiers will go forward to an Area Qualifier held in March 2020.

PASSING DOWN THE LINE

In the event of a competitor being placed in a qualifying position when they have already qualified for the Area Competition the place may pass down the line **provided that the next placed combination has jumped a clear round in the first round.**

AREA QUALIFIERS - DEBUT, WINTER LEAGUE & OPEN GRAND PRIX

Held in 19 Areas throughout the country: March 2020

Non Pony Club Members must become fully paid up Members to compete at an Area Qualifier.
